### SACRED TRADITION

**THE CHURCHES DEDICATION FOR FEBRUARY:** "...is dedicated to the **Holy Family**. #### A Few FEAST DAYS:

**Feb.**  $2^{nd}$  - <u>**Presentation of the Lord**</u> - "occurs forty days after the birth of Jesus and is also known as Candlemas day, since the blessing and procession of candles is included in today's liturgy."

*Feb.* 8<sup>th</sup> – <u>St. Josephine Bakhita</u> – "Saint Josephine was a young Sudanese girl sold into slavery and brought to Italy. There she was baptized, and, having reached majority age, was granted her freedom by Italian law. She died after a long and painful illness, during which she would cry out to the Lord: "Please loosen the chains... they are so heavy!" Her dying words were "Our Lady! Our Lady!"

*Feb.*  $11^{th}$  – <u>Our Lady of Lourdes</u> – "Today marks the first apparition of the Blessed Virgin Mary in 1858 to fourteenyear-old Marie Bernadette (St. Bernadette) Soubirous. Between February 11 and July 16, 1858, the Blessed Virgin appeared eighteen times, and showed herself to St. Bernadette in the hollow of the rock at Lourdes."

*Feb.*  $21^{st}$  – <u>First Sunday of Lent</u> – "Lent is the Christian season of spiritual preparation before Easter. In Western churches, it begins on Ash Wednesday (Feb. 17<sup>th</sup>). During Lent, many Christians observe a period of fasting, repentance, moderation, self-denial, and spiritual discipline. The purpose of the **Lenten season** is to set aside time for reflection on Jesus Christ—to consider HIS suffering and HIS sacrifice, HIS life, death, burial, and resurrection." By Mary Fairchild
