TESTIMONY

Dear St. Dismas Guild, I want to start off by saying that I love the newsletters. I also want to share my true story of my life with the Catholic brothers and sisters.

I am a male and I was born in 1988. My Mom left me when I was six months old. I grew up moving from place to place. When I was 2-6 years old I was abused by my uncles friends physically. From 6-7 I was physically abused by my stepmom until I almost killed her. Around the same time I was sexually abused by my babysitter. Seven to ten years old I spent in the mental institution. At ten when I got out I went into a foster care. While I was there I joined a gang, started doing drugs, carrying guns, stalking people, stealing, pulling armed robbery, and taking cars to a chop shop. So far I have been shot 7 times, stabbed 10 times, and that was all before my 15th birthday. From 16-20 years old I've been in state prison and I'll be here for my 21st birthday. I've done just about everything, grand theft auto, assault with a deadly weapon, shooting at a gang war, and fleeing and avoiding the cops.

I'm glad they caught me because I have no family, no one to care for me but me. If they didn't take me to jail I would've never found Jesus and I probably would be dead right now. God bless you, N.C.

P.S. If you can find a girl my age to write to me so I can have a pen pal I would be very thankful.

Thank you N.C. for writing to us. It sounds like you have had a pretty full life of crime and lonliness. We believe the tremendous importance of a mother in the life of a child. When a child is abandoned by the mother or the father it has life long consequences on them. But that can be healed by our Lord and Savior Jesus Christ. He loves us unconditionally, even if we ignore Him. He is always looking for His lost sheep. As we develop a personal relationship with Jesus through His Word, the bible, asking the Holy Spirit to teach us about Him and His unconditional love, we find healing. In the case of abandonment by a mother you, too, can be healed when you develop a personal relationship with our Blessed Mother. When Jesus died on the cross He told His disciple John, "Behold, your mother." He told His mother, "Behold, your son." This established our Blessed Mother as our mother. All the love that was lacking from your biological mother can be filled by Our Blessed Mother. She loves you whether you say the rosary or just ignore her. She is your mother and will fill you with her love and you too will find healing as you come to her and ask her to love you because you never felt the love of your mother.

In reference to your request for female pen pal... It is not our policy to have female mentors for male inmates. We will send your letter to one of our male mentors. The role of the Spiritual Mentor is to help guide you in your spiritual growth, especially with the Bible Study. The spiritual mentor will Not be a Social Worker or Pen Pal, but one who has been called by Christ to help you in your walk with Jesus. Please send us your faith-based questions and we will assign you to a mentor to help guide you in your journey. God bless you in your faith.

Dear J.L,. The early Apostles traveled to many places spreading the word, some people rejected them and others "...received the word with all willingness and examined the scriptures daily to determine whether these things were so." Acts 11:12. Like those early Christians, you are wise to spend your time examining the Scriptures.

Saint Dismas cannot provide Study Bibles, but we can recommend The Catholic Study Bible from the Oxford University Press. It is based on the third edition of the New American Bible, Revised Edition and contains color maps, a glossary of terms and commentary. It would make the perfect companion to the Bread of Life which was written using the New American Bible.

Father in heaven you have been so much more than a father to me. YOU HAVE ALSO BEEN MY CLOSEST FRIEND. Sometimes I wake up early in the morning hours and I stare at the ceiling suffering with pain and depression. And then I hear a quiet still voice whisper in my ear, Son I am with you all the way, do not drift into the place that satisfies Satan. Take my hand and continue this walk with me. Other times, I get very scared, having panic attacks, and all the odds are stacked against me, and then I opened my Bible to Psalm 27 and I am reminded in time of trouble you will hide me in your shelter. Thank you, Lord, for being such a good friend I can turn to for anything. Amen.

Dear D.G., Not only those incarcerated will this prayer help but all of us especially during this time of the Pandemic when we feel isolated and alone and fearful. He will conceal me in the cover of His tent; and set me high upon a rock." Do we really believe that? It is true. He will do that for all who are depressed or anxious. This is where we find the truth as Jesus says in His prayer to the Father, "Consecrate them in the truth, Your word is truth." (John 17:17) I love the last verse of Psalm 27, "Wait for the Lord, take courage; be stouthearted, wait for the Lord!" As you wait for the Lord study and reflect on His words and continue to turn off the lies of Satan. Your personal relationship with God, D.G., comes through in sending us your letter and prayer. SPIRITUAL DIRECTION w/Fr. Richard

Many times, we receive this question from inmates about not being able to go to Confession, difficulty Praying and dealing with Sin.

The devil attacks us in 4 ways: deception, division, diversion, discouragement. Do not allow Satan to let you fall into discouragement.

Jesus ordinary plan for salvation includes the sacrament of Penance and Eucharist for powerful graces and conversion.

Many people who live in remote areas also cannot avail themselves of these sacraments regularly. Jesus, however, provides HIS grace in many ways outside the sacraments when we cannot receive them when we wish to do so.

In your case, confess directly to Jesus all your sins, your sorrow, ask pardon, and you will receive forgiveness.

Jesus loves you and will be there for you.

When you are able to confess to a priest, do so and even more grace will flow from God to you through the sacrament of Penance.

Romans 10:9-11 9 "for, if you confess with your mouth that Jesus is Lord and believe in your heart that God raised him from the dead, you will be saved. For one believes with the heart and so is justified, and one confesses with the mouth and so is saved. For the scripture says, 'No one who believes in HIM will be put to shame.'"
