I didn't know anything about God when I was on the outside. **I became a Catholic while in prison.** I have been locked up since 2005. I've been through some struggles throughout the years. I have realized I have made it this far in this prison life, thanks to God. He has always been there for me, looking out for me, and now, as we come into this New Year 2022. I have a little under 1-1/2 years till I see parole. I have prayed to God, and I am asking Him to help me make a big change in my life and help me do everything I need to do for parole. Also, can He help me get ready for the world out there.

I know change is hard. We get used to doing things and living a certain way. But for myself, I know it's necessary in order for me to move forward in life. Honestly, I don't know what to expect. I am a bit nervous and a bit scared. I do work on being a good person, a selfless person, asking God to humble me. My dream is to be a writer and I have asked God to help me with my dream throughout all of this. **I know I have to do my part too. It isn't easy but it's something I am willing to do.** I've been locked up since I was young. I know my life can't always be like this, living in prison. I have Hope and Faith that there is something good out there for me. There is light at the end of this tunnel and that light is God. I believe with God at my side I can accomplish anything.

So, I take one step a day in moving forward with my life. I ask if you can pray for me to fulfill my dreams and to do good in life. Also, for courage to keep on going even when life seems hard and depressing. Thank you.

If I may ask, can you please send me a Catholic prayer book? I would also like a prayer card of St. Francis. I Love his prayer of Peace and Love. And also, I'd like a prayer card of the Guardian Angel. Thank you so much and thank you for your time reading my letter. May God bless you with His Love. E.Z.

*Dear E.Z., thank you for writing us and sharing how God is working in your life in the prison system. You say you have Hope and Faith that there is something good out there for you. **“Faith comes through hearing, and what is heard is the word of Christ.” (Romans 10:17)** Staying close to Jesus through the word of God and fellowship with other believers is essential for anyone getting out of prison. God will drive any fear out of you. **“Fear is useless, what is needed is trust.” (Luke 8:50).** God is the only one who is good. Jesus said in **Luke 19:19, “Why call me ‘good’? None is good but God alone.”** That good is right within you. You're right E.Z. with God all things are possible, and you can accomplish anything. **“Ask and you will receive, seek and you will find, knock and the door will be opened to you.” (Luke 11:9)***

*We are praying for you that this year and a half will go quickly and you will be paroled, in the meantime stay close to Jesus in the Bread of Life Catholic Bible Study and when you get out and go to Mass, you will be able to participate to the fullness through the Liturgy of the Word and the Liturgy of the Eucharist, Jesus' real presence Body, Blood, Soul, and Divinity.
