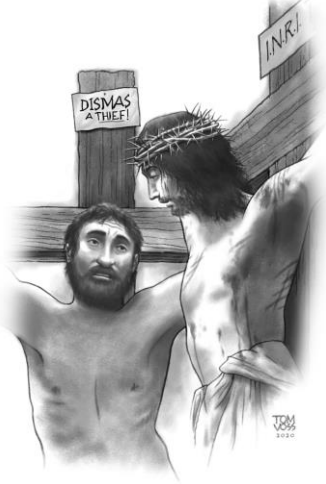

TESTIMONY

Dear Prison Ministry at Saint Dismas Guild, I am D.G. and 85 years of age. I am approaching the center point (halfway) mark of a 16-year sentence for aggravated assault with a weapon (gun). I am a Model Prisoner in only one respect. My case book prison record is spotless. I hope to be given Parole on my first hearing due to my advanced age and somewhat frail physical condition. Mentally I am usually quite capable and normally very alert.

My day of Salvation was in 2015 when I was reconciled back into the Catholic Church. **Father M. came to the jail to hear my confession, my first in 50 years.** I was given my penance, and then I received the Sacrament of the Holy Eucharist. Afterward I was anointed with Holy Oil and offered exorcism. I have been “at Holy Peace” since that day when I rejoined my church.

I cannot wait to receive the catechism to review the many spiritual facts I learned as a youth at the Catholic schools I attended. God bless them for what they did for me, and I am overjoyed with the reconstitution of my Catholic faith. I am also looking forward to reading and absorbing the church’s explanation of Revelation. It is almost unbelievable the various interpretations by self-proclaimed ministers I have heard over my many years. I look forward to hearing from you and continuing the discussion on our Catholic Faith. God Bless you and keep you safe in this turbulent world. Amen. D.G.

Dear D.G., *“Grace to you and peace from God our Father and the Lord Jesus Christ.” 1 Corinthians 1:3* In your letter, you said that after making your confession, you had been anointed. The Catechism of the Catholic Church explains the purpose of anointing as “the conferral of a special grace on the Christian experiencing the difficulties inherent in the condition of grave illness or old age. “[Catechism 1527]

When you read and study the CCC, you will learn so much about the faith and practices of the church using scripture and the authentic teachings of the Catholic Church

and not someone else’s interpretation or opinion. It will answer many questions and help deepen your faith.

As you wait for your parole hearing, pray from your heart asking God that if it is His Divine Will, you will be paroled. Then whatever the outcome, be at peace trusting that this is what is best for you. Please write and let us know.

I have struggled my whole life, going back 30 plus years with homosexuality, and I believe that my recent deliverance from this affliction has resulted because of this Catholic belief. **I’m happy to report that I no longer live nor lead a sinful lifestyle that I once lead.** I want to publicly thank Him and give Him all the glory for taking away all desires for that life. 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Hello, My Friends, I have been sentenced to 18 years and I know it's not as much as life, but I've realized a lot of things. When my time was given right now, I wish I could have found God sooner. I know my life wouldn't have ended up the way it did. I've lost a lot of things, like desires lusting after the flesh. I have a beautiful wife and kids all a gift from God that I abused and took for granted. I let my fleshly desires become the foundation of my relationship so when times got hard and the storms and temptations came, the love wasn't strong enough to keep my relationship together. Yet it wasn't first in my life at the time, so sex became my relationships strong point, a point that pinned me down in life. It was my lustful desires for my soon-to-be wife instead of love which drove her away and other women nearby. I went crazy with a broken heart and to make things worse in my life I got arrested.

Finding God in a place like this has become a blessing and the best thing I could have ever imagined. God has shown me in the time that I've been down how to love without touch, sight, smell or anything of the flesh. My strong point now is to learn to love with my heart and the Spirit that He has given me. I know that God, if it is His will, will reunite my life back with my wife and kids. God has shown me that to make the foundation to put Him first would form a strong kind of love that will withstand the temptations and trials and storms that the desires of the flesh can give. So, Brethren, please, **I pray for you to make God first in your relationship before the devilish lust of the flesh takes it away.** God bless and search the Bible for your strength that you need to conquer your lustful ways. Praise God and thank Him for the graces that He has given us. Put all your love into Jesus and He will change your life. M.A.
