TESTIMONY

Dear St. Dismas Guild, my name is J.J., and I was born in Haiti. I grew up in a Catholic-rooted family and my sister and I attended Catholic school. My mother and father kept us in church. At the age of seven years old both my parents passed away and I moved in with my aunt in Florida. My aunt did her best to raise us in the church but in my teenage years I became rebellious. I moved in with my sister when I was 18 years old and got a good job. Around that time, I fell in with the wrong crowd and started getting into trouble. At 22 I had my first child and began to take life more seriously. I did the best I could to provide for my family but even though I believed in Christ I was lukewarm doing what I wanted and justifying it because of my good fortune.

Fast forward, I caught my first federal charge at age 34. This was the situation that forced me to reevaluate my life and make some changes. I have been walking seriously with God the last two years. Currently I am in special housing awaiting transfer to a low facility. This is one of the hardest challenges I am dealing with because I have been living right and doing God's will. So being locked down 23 hours a day and not committing any offense to deserve it has been difficult to understand. But the more I pray and meditate on His Word, the better I've been able to deal with and understand how He is using this situation to make me a better disciple. I have been locked down because of a mistake and it was discovered, and I am in solitary until I am transferred. I hope my testimony will help someone. "Trust in the Lord with all your heart and lean not on your own understanding. Acknowledge Him in all your ways. He will direct your path."

Dear J.J, you have good roots being born in a Catholic-rooted family. It must have been very hard for you and your sister to lose your parents at age 7. Satan's attack on you began in your teen years when you decided to rebel. John 10:10 says, "The thief comes to steal and slaughter and destroy; I came so that they might have life, and have it more abundantly." Satan comes in and edges you on when

you want to live your way and not God's way. God's way is what scripture says and staying under the headship of the Church. You made the effort to provide for your family, but you were not rooted in the Word of God, so you became lukewarm. Scripture says what happens to one who is lukewarm. "But because you are lukewarm, neither hot nor cold, I will spew you out of my mouth." Revelation 3:16. It is good you see that God is using your situation to make you a better disciple. God sees your heart we look at appearance. He loves you very much and those He loves He disciplines. God bless you. You are in our prayers.

DOING TIME WITH JESUS

Hello. It's a great day. I feel good today as I'm taking 24 items to the Catholic Worship Service this afternoon. I've put them in a pillowcase, then set it below the Eucharist. At the end of Mass Our Leader will pass it out to the indigent. It is 10 percent of the incoming deposit from my family. The real challenge is making it through the month without asking for more money. It will only create spiritual balance. The indigent don't even have the option. My brother and my mom have been dependable and support me every day I've been in prison. And they don't even go to church. On top of that, I barely spoke to them before I got locked up. Please join me in prayer for them. And also, my grandparents.

Today I'm a servant, a part of the servanthood of the faithful. Even today's Mass speaks of me. I really love daily Mass. I'm doing the work of Jesus. I had to write to you all. On Thursday night when I got your newsletter, I was feeling elated to hear from my Christian family. So, I went into deep prayer seeing your concerns for donations. I would like to assure you that there is a Pot of Gold at the end of every rainbow (Covenant). Just stay in faith and more than you can imagine will come from Angels. God is faithful. Throughout the week I do the Bible Study. It opens my mind to Scripture. I do it every week. We need you to keep the Prison Ministry. I'll write to Papa Pope Francis if I have to. He'll send you a check.

Prison life is stressful, always a break in concentration. Thanks for your support. I've been reading the Revelation book you sent me. "As we celebrate the memorial of His death and resurrection, we offer you Lord the Bread of Life and Chalice of Salvation giving thanks that you have helped us, worthy to be in your presence and minister to you. Humbly we pray that partaking of the Body and Blood of Christ..." that's where I'm at. But this makes me die to self-daily. I feel like this is my job now as worker in the Servanthood for Christ. D.C.

It is so good D.C. that you have the support of your mom and brother. It must have been the Word of God that gave you the desire to give to the poor. "It is God who, in His good will toward you, begets in you any measure of desire or achievement." Philippians 2:13

St. Mother Teresa had the faith to do her work with the poor and put total trust in God to provide the means to do so. It sounds like your faith has grown tremendously that you trust God to get you through the month. He always comes through. The more you give the more you receive. "Faith then comes through hearing and what is heard is the Word of Christ." Romans 10:17

Continue doing the bible study with the understanding that the Holy Spirit is your Teacher. Ask Him to teach you how to live. The greatest pot of gold we can receive is to see you transformed by the power of God's Word and become God's disciple. May you experience His loving touch on you and be healed.
